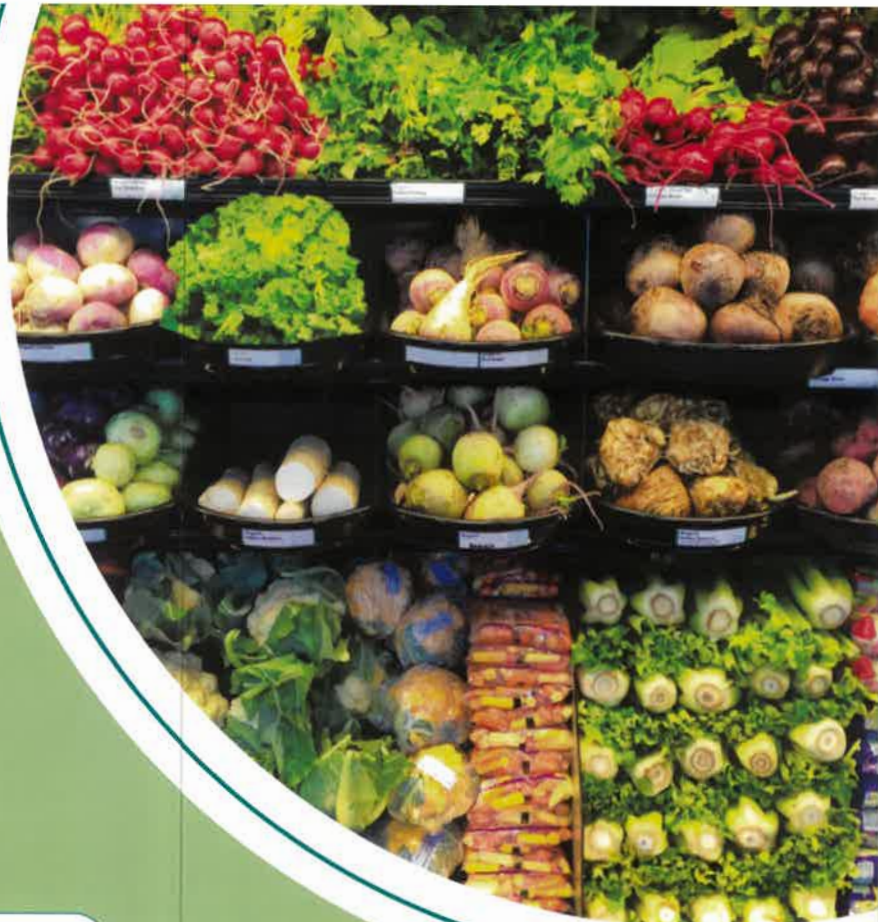

# A Collective Voice.

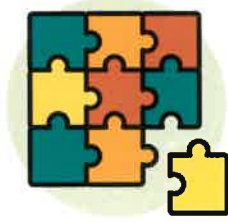
Food and nutrition insecurity impacts an individual's ability to thrive.
