# Eligibility

## Eligible Organizations

- Verified Nonprofit or Charitable Organization
  - Tax ID# is verified nonprofit with the IRS
  - 501(c)(3) Status
- Units of government, schools & churches
- Organizations may use a Fiscal Sponsor
  - Provides financial management and administrative services.

## Not Eligible

- Private businesses
- Individuals
- Organizations on IRS Auto-Revocation List due to not filing appropriate forms
- SDCF will not consider organizations until they've received an affirmative Determination Letter from the IRS.

# South Dakota Fund Timeline



Application Stage	Timeline/Due Date
Letter of Inquiry (LOI)	LOIs are accepted on a rolling basis.
LOI Decision: Invited or Denied	SDCF responds to LOIs within 15 working days.
Application	Applications are due 60 days after SDCF sends out an invitation to apply.
Application Decision: Awarded, Denied or Holdover	SDCF informs an applicant of their status approximately 90 days of the application submission date.





# South Dakota Fund

- Program/Project Expenses
- Match required:
  - Other Grants
  - Donors
  - Fundraisers
  - In-kind
- Rolling Grant Program
  - Letter of Inquiry
  - Application
- Twelve-month waiting period
- Must take place in South Dakota



# South Dakota Fund

## 2026 Initiatives:

- Child Well-Being, Housing, Workforce Development
  - Grant Sizes:
    - Development up to \$50,000
    - Implementation up to \$100,000
- Child Well-Being:
  - Impact of child's well-being at all stages of development.
- Housing:
  - Development, access and sustainability of affordable housing options for all.
- Workforce Development:
  - Programs & strategies aimed at enhancing workforce skills & improving employment opportunities.



# South Dakota Fund



# Nonprofit Savings Account

## Endowment Building Challenge Grants:

### Grant Size:

- \$1 for every \$4 raised for an endowment, up to \$20,000
- To receive full \$20,000, \$80,000 must be raised - creating a \$100,000 endowment
- Fundraising timeframe is 2 years
- Endowment to benefit nonprofit organization
  - Fund balance invested in perpetuity
  - 4.5% of the average fair market value is available annually

### Timeframe:

- Rolling


# Beyond Idea Grants

in partnership with the Bush Foundation

- Community based problem-solving grants
- Grant Sizes: \$5,000 - \$100,000/year
  - Development up to \$50,000
  - Testing/Spreading up to \$100,000
- Multi-year funding may be considered
- No Match Required
- \$1.2 million available in 2026
- Competitive

# Beyond Idea Grants

## Important Considerations:

- Community-based **problem solving**
- To design, test and spread **ideas**
- To inspire, equip and connect **leaders**
- **Planning** or **Implementation** Grants
- **Community** impact potential



# Beyond Idea Grants

## Important Criteria for BIG



- What is the community problem being addressed?
- How does the idea address the problem in an innovative and collaborative way?
- Is the idea realistic and likely to succeed?
- How are key stakeholders meaningfully involved?

## **BIG will not fund**



- Solely general operating expenses
- General program and project costs
- Loans
- Construction

# Bush Prize: South Dakota

in partnership with the Bush Foundation

- **Award:**

- Extraordinary organizations that consistently engage and lead their community toward creative solutions.

- **Grant Size:**

- 2 Honorees will be awarded \$250,000 EACH
  - Finalists receive \$10,000 EACH

- **Track record:**

- Successful community problem-solving

- **Grant Use:**

- Flexible. Award can be used to build up reserves or test that next big idea or whatever else would best support the organization's ongoing good work

# Bush Prize: South Dakota

## Eligibility

- **Verified Nonprofit or Charitable Organizations**
  - Tax ID# is registered as nonprofit with the IRS
  - 501(c)(3) Status
  - Units of government, schools & churches
  - A verified organization may serve as a Fiscal Sponsor for other initiatives
- **Must be located in South Dakota or one of the 9 Native nations that share the same geography.**
  - Community innovations highlighted must also have occurred within that geography.
- **Previous Bush Prize winners are not eligible for 10 years**
  - Organizations who have been finalists are eligible to apply again

# Bush Prize: South Dakota

## Criteria

- **Transformational Impact** - organizations which have created meaningful, long-lasting change to address the challenges and issues affecting their community.
- **History of Creative Solutions** – honors organizations which have a history at least three to five years of using innovative approaches that offer real solutions for the challenges and issues affecting their communities.
- **Creative Community Problem Solving** – honors organizations which have proven to be deeply rooted in their communities and value driven.
- **Additional Considerations** - Over time we seek a portfolio of honorees representing the full diversity of South Dakota, and includes a variety of:
  - *Organization sizes*
  - *Communities served (size and demographics)*
  - *Types of issues addressed*



# Bush Prize: South Dakota 2025 Honorees (\$250,000 Each)


Abbott House provides customized treatment for each child they serve to reflect upon their unique needs. Residential Psychiatric Treatment Facility uses a wide range of evidence-based interventions, such as Neurofeedback, Sensory Diets, Mood Management, Grief and Loss Groups, and Independent Living Skills, in addition to twice-a-week individual therapy sessions.



YFS provides evidence-informed, developmentally appropriate, and culturally responsive education, prevention, and recreation programs, health-care services, case management; trauma-informed counseling, mentoring, healthy relationships education, nutritious meals, training and technical assistances, and other support services.



## Home Screen

The South Dakota Fund awards grants throughout the year to nonprofit organizations that meet vital and diverse needs across the state.

Verified nonprofits with 501(c)(3) status from the IRS, under Publication 78

**Not Eligible:**

Individuals

Private businesses

\*\*Fiscal sponsorship is a partnership with a verified nonprofit organization (the sponsor) and an organized group that does not have its nonprofit status. They offer their tax-exempt status to groups engaged in activities related to the sponsor's mission. This arrangement is beneficial for projects or initiatives that are not separately incorporated as nonprofits but wish to apply for grants.

# GOapply

## Frequently Asked Questions:

- I created my User Registration, why can't I log in?
  - SDCF staff complete due diligence on all new users before new users can log into the portal. Staff look for:
    1. Is the EIN provided correct and does the name entered match the IRS.
    2. Does the organization name entered match our records.
    3. Is this a new organization that is not currently in our system.
    4. Does the organization already have a person already approved.
- What is the difference between a submitter and contributor?
  - Submitters are allowed to start, edit, complete, and submit applications. Organizations may only have one submitter.
  - Contributors are allowed to review & edit their organizations applications, but the submit button does not exist. Organizations may have as many contributors as needed.
- I need more space to provide the answer to the question.
  - Each question will state the character limit and count down as you type your answer. Be mindful of the space provided.

# GOapply

## Frequently Asked Questions:

- My organization information did not auto-populate from the organization profile, and I cannot enter the information.
  - Developers are aware of this issue and working towards a solution. It mainly happens with new users/organizations. The information does download into our system correctly.
- My organization has had some staffing changes and I am now the new Submitter for GOapply, what do I need to do?
  - Please contact SDCF staff and we will make the necessary edits.
- My application or evaluation is not in my “In Progress” tab?
  - Please contact Stephanie Harmon, she will make sure your document is loaded correctly.
- How do I print my submitted documents?
  - On the Submitted tab, click on the Download tab beside the document you want to print. A PDF is created and ready for printing.
- I can no longer access my application. Why?
  - Organizations have 60 days from the date on the approval email to submit the full application. Once the 60 days have passed, organizations will no longer have access to the application.
