in South Dakota.




Private Foundation




Geographic Distribution South Dakota Public Charities



Public Charity Density of South Dakota, with Comparable States





Number of South Dakota Private Foundations, with Comparable States





Percentage of Revenue Source for South Dakota Public Charities





Inner Ring—Percentage of Total Number of Organizations


Outer Ring—Percentage of Total Revenue



South Dakota Public Charity Revenue





South Dakota Public Charities Expenditures





Flow of Grant Dollars Into South Dakota between 2010-2015




