Beresford Area Foundation Grant Application Criteria

The Beresford Area Foundation accepts grant application from February 15th through April 1st each year. The BAF Grant Committee score the applications, forwards recommendations to the Foundation Board of Directors, and the Board makes grant awards at their April meeting. All grant applicants will be notified of the status of their application in writing by May 1st.

Organizations that have been IRS verified and have a Tax ID Number are eligible to receive a direct grant distribution form the Beresford Area Foundation. Organizations that have not been IRS verified can still be eligible to receive a grant, however they will be required to submit additional documentation to the Foundation upon grant approval.

Grant Guidelines

The Beresford Area Foundation accepts grant applications that are directed toward specific projects or programs that will enhance the quality of life for Beresford residents. Grant applications to fund recurring programs, ongoing operations, payroll, or overhead expenses are generally not eligible for consideration. To avoid undue reliance on Foundation grant funds, specific projects are generally not eligible for grants awards for more than two consecutive years.

Grant awards are generally approved in the range between \$500 and \$5,000, with exceptions considered based on the merit of individual proposals. Larger funding requests, multi-year funding requests, or a combination thereof may be proposed for larger projects with significant community-wide impact.

The Foundation Grant Committee scores grant applications using a weighted matrix that includes consideration of these criteria:

- 1. Benefit of proposed project/program
- 2. Community support of project/program
- 3. Number of people impacted
- 4. Cost per person impacted
- 5. Timeline of project
- 6. Likelihood of ongoing success
- 7. Financial or in-kind contributions by applicant
- 8. Contributions by other organizations
- 9. Advance planning and logistics of project/program
- 10. Track record of submitting organization

Administrative of Grant Awards

Grants awards may only be used for the purpose stated on the application. The Foundation may require a site visit to monitor progress and confirm accomplishment of project objectives. Applicants must inform the Foundation office in writing of any significant changes in project status, organizational status or project implementation.

Verification of project progress is required prior to distribution of grant funds. Requests for a change in project eligible expenses must be submitted to the Foundation prior to expenditure of grant funds to avoid default on the grant award.

Organizations receiving grant awards are required to complete a brief *Project Review and Evaluation* form and submit it to the Foundation within 60 days of expenditure of grant funds.
