


> South Dakota Fund Grants

- Competitive Grant Program
- Awarded 55 grants totaling over \$800,000
- Grants range from \$2,000 \$50,000
- Accepts applications throughout the year



> Beyond Idea Grant (BIG) Program

- Partnership with the Bush Foundation
- Problem-solving grants
- Reviewed 93 applications, awarded 13 grants totaling \$1.2 million
- Grants range from \$5,000 \$100,000

- Grant Cycle
 - o **ONE** Round
 - Applications Accepted: June 1 July 31
 - ✓ Hard close on July 31 at Noon CT
 - o Award Announcement: November 28
- Total of \$1.2 million available


- > Bush Prize: South Dakota 2024


> Build Dakota Scholarship Program

> Freedom Scholarship Program


- Third year of awards



- ➤ Endowed Assets: \$20 million





Investment Objectives

- ➤ Partnership with South Dakota Investment Council
- > Three Investment Objectives:
 - Protect donors' gifts
 - Provide a steady stream of income to charitable and nonprofit causes
 - Produce growth in the fund value over time
- ➤ 2024 Rate of Return: 8.5%

Washington Update

- New Administration
- Concern over recent policy shifts and executive orders
- Some of those have been rescinded, leaving more questions
- SDCF will continue to be a resource to our nonprofit partners
- Committed to connecting our donors with causes that are important to them

➤ 2025 Tax Updates

- IRA Qualified Charitable Deduction (QCD) indexed to \$108,000
- IRA life-income rollover is indexed to \$54,000
- Gift tax exclusion is \$19,000/person
- Gift/Estate tax exemption is \$13.99 million/person
